Stewardship Corner Finally! A New Church Directory

Sharing is Regular and Intentional (even in the summer!)



It's August and we are trying to enjoy every minute Intentional of our precious Minnesota summer! Minnesotans go up to the lakes or pile the family in the car for a cross country adventure. Although we might miss a few Sunday worship ser-

vices while on the road, we can still make a plan to remember Abiding Savior in our sharing.

Pastor Charles Lane writes about the characteristics of a biblical giver in his book, Ask, Thank, Tell. Two of those characteristics are that a biblical giver gives intentionally and gives regularly. An intentional giver has a plan for their sharing. They make generosity a part of their overall financial plan and then they live out that plan of sharing. A biblical giver also gives regularly. They do not share only when they feel like sharing, or only when they attend worship services. Instead, they share as a practice of their faith.

One easy way to ensure that our giving is regular and intentional is to set up an automatic giving plan where our gifts to Abiding Savior are automatically given through electronic funds transfer every month. This method of giving is intentional because we have to choose an amount to give monthly, and it is regular because this giving happens whether we are at church, the cabin, or on the beaches of Florida. If you are interested in signing up for this service, please contact the church office.

We are called by God to give intentionally and regularly. Practicing generosity in this way is helpful to Abiding Savior, especially as we are in the middle of these summer months. As people are busy with cabins, vacations, and summer activities, church attendance dips and so do offerings. I encourage you to make a plan for sharing and to follow that plan regularly this summer and every season of the year.
