Trust in the Lord

It's getting hard to watch the news. Mass shootings, war in Ukraine, refugees fleeing their homeland, politics dividing our country, community, and families. There is a lot to worry about and if we chose to do so, we could end up letting that worry overcome our lives. Worry can lead us to fear and fear leads us to actions that are not in the best interest of our neighbor. Instead of coming



together, we draw lines of division sometimes fueled by hate instead of love.

But we are called by God to love, not to hate. We are called to trust, not to worry. IN Matthew Chapter Six Jesus teaches us, "Therefore I tell you, do not worry about your life, which of you by worrying can add a single hour to your span of life?...Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow; they neither toil nor spin, yet I tell you, even Solomon in all his glory was not clothed like one of these. But if God so clothes the grass of the field, which is alive today and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, will he not much more clothe you—you of little faith?...But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well. So do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will bring worries of its own."

There is a certain comfort in trusting in God instead of worrying. There is so much in this life we cannot control no matter how hard we try. When we admit we are not in control and we turn over our worry to God, we experience relief that can lead to empathy, caring, and respect instead of resentment, jealousy and worry. God loves us, God knows what is best for us, and God will care for us and our needs in this world.

Instead of giving in to worry, fear, or hatred, we can instead turn to God and learn to love, care and trust. As Proverbs says, "Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not rely on your own insight. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths." (Proverbs 3:5-6)

Stewardship as an Investment (Not Just Giving)

Stewardship is often thought of as giving money to the church or other organizations. But what if we thought about our stewardship more as an investment instead of a gift. This investment does not bring us a financial return, but instead pays off in other ways. Through our sharing, our investment in Abiding Savior, we are rewarded by seeing our children grow to feel know and share God's love. We are paid back over and over through weekly worship services and Bible study opportunities. We see a return on our investment knowing that the sick are visited, the elderly cared for, and those in our community are provide with food, shelter, and other basic needs. We share together in the loving fellowship provided through our congregation.

Investing, or giving, to your church is a response to the many blessing God has given to us. God created us, sustains us in this life, has given us everything we call your own, sent Jesus to die for our sins, forgives us when we don't deserve to be forgiven, and grants us eternal life in Heaven with God. How can we not want to give back to God?

One way to give back is to make an "investment" in the work of God done in and through Abiding Savior. As together we live in God's love, we will continue to mold our congregation to be a welcoming and caring family that nurtures spiritual growth, shares our Christian faith, and serves all creation.

Where are My Offering Envelopes?

That is a good question that we have been asking for the past seven months! Last winter our envelopes were shipped to the wrong location and never arrived at Abiding Savior. We expected the company to get us our envelopes, but it appears they are not able to do so. There will be no "official" offering envelopes for 2023.



That being said, you can still make your gifts to the congregation in several different ways:

- 1. We have printed temporary offering envelopes that are available at every worship service. You can place your offering in the envelope and write your name on the outside. NO ENVELOPE NUMBER IS NEEDED! With just your name we can be sure to track your giving appropriately for your annual statement.
- 2. We will have bundles of the temporary envelopes available that you can take home with you to mail in your offering or prepare your offering at home before coming to church.
- 3. Electronic giving is a great way to share! You can choose to make a gift from your checking account or on your credit card. Your gift can be set up to be given automatically monthly, weekly, or annually. You can also make a one time electronic gift through our website or by using your phone and the QR code provided.
- 4. The church receives several gifts of stocks, IRA's, and other securities throughout the year. This can be a great way to avoid paying taxes on the earnings from your investments while making a gift to Abiding Savior.

Women's Bible Study When Bad Things Happen to Good People

Did you ever wonder why bad things happen to good people? It's a question most of us ask from time to time as we look around the world and see things that just don't seem fair. The women's Bible study group will be exploring this question in more depth this summer as we read and discuss the classic book by Rabbi Harold Kushner.

Rabbi Kushner's son, Aaron, was born with a debilitating illness that caused much suffering and resulted in Aaron's death at age 14. This personal experience of family suffering, combined with Rabbi Kushner's pastoral role in accompanying people in his congregation through many life challenges, prompted him to delve into the question of where God is at when bad things happen to good people. He looks to Old Testament scriptures, prayer, and his relationship with God to guide his consideration of this difficult life reality.

Our study of this book continues in August and September! Any women in the congregation who would like to participate in this study are welcome! The Women's Bible Study group meets each week on Thursday mornings from 10:00 to about 11:30 in our church Coffee House, led by Pastor Marla. The chapters of the book are short. It's an easy read. It helps to read it, but you can participate even if you don't read the book since the questions it addresses are common to all of us and our discussion will draw heavily on our own life experiences. We hope you'll join us!


