As we move through this time of transition, we must do so with faith and hope in God's plans for our congregation. Like I said, Abiding Savior is God's church and God will continue to provide us with what we need. The Holy Spirit is guiding our call process and the strategic planning of our Church Council. Abiding Savior is now in its 85th year of existence. We have seen many pastors and many members come and go. The one constant is that God has journeyed with this place and will continue to do so for years to come.

May God bless the congregation as together we live in God's love as a welcoming and caring family that nurtures spiritual growth, shares our Christian faith, and serves all God's creation.

We're nearing the end of our summer worship schedule. Please join us!


- On Communion Sundays (1st & 3rd Sunday of the month), we will worship inside.
