### Worship Moved to Online Only and Other COVID-19 Updates

Due to the recent spikes in COVID-19 cases in our community and out of abundant love for our neighbor, the Abiding Savior Reopening Task Force recommended that indoor in person worship be suspended until the week of January 4th, 2021 at which time there will be re-evaluation of the safety of returning to in person worship. At the discretion of the Pastors, they may allow select sacraments and rites such as communion, funerals, baptisms and weddings.

What does this mean?

- Sunday services. Sunday worship services will be available online only.
  - Services will be streamed on <u>Facebook Live</u> each Sunday at 10am.
  - Services are also available to watch on our <u>website</u>.
- **Funerals, weddings, baptisms and communion.** Funerals, weddings, baptisms, and communion services may still happen within reason and at the discretion of the pastors. However, Abiding Savior will always abide by the regulations set in place by the Governor and the Minnesota Department of Health.
- Weekly studies/meetings. Our men's and women's Bible studies will no longer meet in person. Thursday morning Bible study with Pastor Lisa will continue to be available online. Other meetings (staff, council, etc.) will continue to meet via Zoom.
  - Pastor Lisa's Bible study is streamed on <u>Facebook Live</u> each Thursday at 10am.
  - Thursday morning Bible study is also available to watch on our <u>website</u>.
  - Watch for more online education offerings after the first of the year.
  - Children's ministries and choirs as well as Sunday School will continue to meet online as scheduled.
- **Christmas Eve services.** We will not be able to worship inside with the live animals and glow of candles as we have in the past. Instead,
  - We invite you to watch our Christmas Eve service on Facebook Live or our website. The service will premiere at 12:00 PM on Christmas Eve and can be watched anytime after that on <u>Facebook</u> or <u>YouTube</u> via our <u>website</u> at <u>www.abidingsavior.org</u>.
  - Weather permitting, we hope to hold a brief service in the church parking lot to hear the Christmas story from the Gospel of Luke and to sing some of our favorite Christmas hymns. We'll communicate the time of this service once it's determined.
- **Office hours.** With our local school districts in remote learning for all grades, our office hours (during which staff are physically at church) will continue to be reduced. Please contact us via phone (763-784-5120; leave a message as needed) or email (<u>office@abidingsavior.org</u>), if possible.

# **Creative Year End Sharing Ideas**



As we head into the end of the year, here are some creative ways to give to Abiding Savior. These sharing tips come with added tax savings benefits that you

might not otherwise receive for your gift if you do not itemize on your tax return. They are a win-win for you and for the work of God done in and through Abiding Savior!

#### Tax Free Sharing with Abiding Savior from Your IRA!!



For those of you who are 70½ years old or older, there is an exciting way that your gift to Abiding Savior can go even further. For 2019, it is possible for anyone 70½ years of age or older to make a gift to Abiding

Savior from their Individual Retirement Account (IRA) and have it be <u>completely tax free</u>. Instead of taking a cash distribution from your IRA, which will be taxed as income, and then making a cash donation to the church, you can choose to direct your IRA custodian to send a donation directly to Abiding Savior. This results in a non-taxable transfer of funds. Instead of paying taxes to the IRS, you could increase your gifts to Abiding Savior by 20% or more instead of paying that amount to the IRS in taxes. This donation from your IRA also qualifies as your required minimum distribution (RMD) from your IRA.

#### Donate Stock, Bonds, or Mutual Funds to Abiding Savior

New tax laws can make it harder to see a tax advantage in your charitable giving. One way you can still see a tax advantage, even if you do not itemize your donations, is by donating long-term appreciated securities, including stock, bonds, and mutual funds, directly to Abiding Savior. Compared with selling your appreciated securities and contributing the after-tax proceeds, you may be able to make a bigger impact by increasing your gift and your tax deduction.

Donating appreciated securities is simple and easy. When you donate stock, bonds or mutual funds to Abiding Savior, you'll generally take a tax deduction for the full fair market value. And because you are donating stock, bonds or mutual funds, your contribution and tax deduction may increase because you may not have to pay any capital gains tax on your appreciated securities.\*

Donating your stocks, bonds, or mutual funds directly to Abiding Savior is a win-win situation. Instead of paying the IRS, that tax savings can be used to increase your donation toward the work of God done in and through our congregation. Contact your financial planner or accountant and ask them about the value of donating appreciated securities to Abiding Savior. Some people even make two years gifts with one sale of stock covering their pledge for the current year and the year to come.
