
# Tree of Sharing

# Scholarships for Students from Makungu Parish





the government of Tanzania supports only primary schools for all children in the local areas. Those students wishing to continue higher education on the secondary levels, must enter boarding schools. The Tanzanian government provides secondary schools in a region, yet most students attend private schools. The Evangelical Lutheran Church of Tanzania (ELCT) operates 6 secondary schools throughout the Iringa Diocese (similar to our St Paul Area Synod). In addition to secondary scholarships, our Tanzania ministry is also providing opportunities for post-secondary scholarships for students in colleges and universities.

The Tanzanian secondary system involves 6 levels (called Forms) which must be passed each year by a formal examination. Passing the initial 4 Forms result in a choice between continuing on with Forms 5 and 6 to earn a professional diploma and/or prepare for a university degree (BS, MS, D).

Currently, we are supporting 12 students: 10 in secondary schools, 1 at the University of Iringa, and one in technical education. The support varies as amounts are awarded by our Makungu parish committee based on type and level of school as well as family need. The range of scholarship funding is \$250 to \$500. Abiding Savior commits to an annual amount for scholarships rather than identifying individuals. We have pledged to continue our support in 2024 at the same level of \$5,000.

With five of our Makungu students reaching Forms 5 and 6, we have an opportunity to support advanced education through the Postsecondary funds of the Iringa Diocese. Recipients are selected annually for additional support through an interview process involving the Scholarship Committee of United States and Tanzanian representatives. This fund is administered separately from the Makungu parish committee and is supported by many congregations in the Saint Paul Area Synod. At this date, ASLC is not part of this specific funding, yet students from Makungu are eligible to apply. # New Committee Forming—Makungu Parish, Tanzania

Opportunities abound in ways to support the mission and ministry of Abiding Savior - local, regional, national and international arenas. The children's globe offerings are a frequent reminder of our international partnership with the Makungu Parish in Tanzania. Yet what is this partnership really about? The scholarship program is one part of this ministry as are our prayers for the members in Tanzania. We have supported the travel of two groups and two individuals in the past 13 years. We provide funds each year through our globe contributions and have supported construction projects in Makungu and preaching points. Recently we have supplied a motorbike for the pastor to visit the many preaching points in the mountainous Makungu region. Following the last group visit, we have been approved for a project to bring clean water up the mountain to Makungu through the Saint Paul Partners water affiliate with the Saint Paul Area Synod and the University of Minnesota School of Engineering.

A committee is being formed in order to emphasize our partnership with Tanzania. It may, yet does not need to be limited to a focus on international travel.
