Joy to the World!



Thank you for your generosity this year!

As we approach the final weeks of 2024, the Council would like to provide an update on our congregation's financial position.

As of the end of October, we have received \$472,640 in offerings this year—thank you for your continued support! Our expenses through October have totaled \$493,400 resulting in a current deficit of \$20,760. Both the Council and staff have remained diligent, bringing our spending in under budget.

As we close out 2024, we ask that you prayerfully consider your giving toward the work God is doing in and through Abiding Savior. Through all of us sharing generously, we can more that close this gap setting up a solid foundation for ministry in 2025 and the years to come.

Makungu Water Project

Abiding Savior is blessed to be participating in bringing fresh, clean, and sustainable drinking water to the 1,500 inhabitants of the village of Makungu, Tanzania. Abiding Savior is a partner congregation to the Makungu Parish. We are working with the University of Minnesota School of Engineering and St. Paul Partners to make this water project a reality. Our goal is to raise \$18,000 toward this project that will dramatically improve the health of the people of Makungu and change their lives for the better. You are invited to make a donation toward this worthy project in the yellow envelopes found in the Narthex and the church Office, online, or in the offering plate at any worship service. 
