Sun., Feb. 27 The Life of Village Lutheran Churches in Tanzania

By Rev. Nordphrey Mlangali, Doctoral Student at Luther Seminary and pastor in the Evangelical Lutheran Church of Tanzania



Pastor Nordphrey Mlangali will share with us about the life of the Lutheran Church in Tanzanian villages, like our companion congregation in Makungu. He will share what drives or motivates people in villages to love church, especially compared to people who live in big cities. In the villages, worship services last 3-6 hours, but people in villages never complain. In big cities in Tanzania, people are willing to listen to long sermons or sit through long worship services. In order to go to the church, many people in the villages have to walk long distances and are happy to spend all day in the village celebrating the "Lord's Day."

Pastor Nordphrey will discuss what we can learn from these village churches. He will draw comparisons with Jesus and his teaching mostly in small village. He will share some of the history of the Lutheran Church in Tanzania including how early Christian missionaries focused the villages and not the cities. He will also discuss more differences between the village churches in Tanzania and the city churches.
