### Annual Meeting and Call Committee

It is with great anticipation that the Congregational Council announces the Annual Meeting of Abiding Savior Lutheran Church will be held on Sunday, February 11, at 11:30 AM in the Fellowship Hall. We know that the business, or governance, side of the church is not always the most exciting, but it is terribly important. As Lutherans we believe that the congregation belongs to all of its members, not to any small group of people or any pastor. As such, it is terribly important to exercise your power! You are invited to participate in the life of your congregation.

At the Annual Meeting we will conduct the business of the church. These items of business will include elections of Council members and committee members, review of the 2023 financial statements, approval of the 2024 budget, as well as written reports from our staff and committees. There will be opportunity for discussion questions and debate as together we discern where God is leading us in 2024.

As a part of this Annual Meeting, we are also excited to announce that we will be having a special election for a Call Committee to begin the process of calling a new Associate Pastor. The Call Committee will be responsible for completing a Ministry Site Profile about Abiding Savior, listening to the congregation about what they are looking for in a new Associate Pastor, interviewing candidates for the position and ultimately making a recom-



mendation to the congregation on who to call as our next pastor at Abiding Savior. How exciting to be a part of such an important decision in shaping the future of our church!

The Call Committee will consist of seven members and will be elected through nominations from the Nominating Committee and nominations from the floor. If you are interested in serving on the Call Committee or would like to nominate someone for the call committee, please contact Congregational Vice-President Karn Matthews at Karn.matthews2004@gmail.com.

The Annual Meeting will be preceded by a soup and sandwich luncheon hosted by our youth attending the national ELCA Youth Gathering in New Orleans this summer. All proceeds from the soup sandwich luncheon will support their trip.



### LENT 2024—Dress for Success: A Wardrobe of Faith

In a world filled with turmoil and discord, Lent provides a wonderful opportunity to take some time out for renewal and restoration of harmony. For our mid-week Lenten worship services, we will use the beautiful Holden Evening Prayer liturgy and reflect on a passage from Colossians 3:12-17. Through Jesus, we have been chosen and set apart as God's redeemed. What does it mean to live as God's people in the world? The apostle, Paul, addresses this question in his letter to the Colossians. As followers of Christ, we are to let go of old vices and "clothe" ourselves in virtues such as compassion, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience. Living in Christian community provides a place to live in harmony with God and with one another.

Sunday Mornings, 9:00-9:50 a.m. Parents are encouraged to enjoy fellowship in the library during this time.



### Women's Retreat | Apr. 19-21

Stories are so powerful. They draw us in as we learn about the lives and experiences of people that are similar to our own, yet each one is unique. 
#### Parent Night — Wednesday, February 7, 6:30 to 8:00
