Abiding Here for 50 Years Capital Campaign is a Success



Back in May of 2022, we launched our *Abiding Here* **for** 50 Years Capital Campaign. With the beginning of the new year, we completed the campaign and Lam happy to announce the campaign

completed the campaign, and I am happy to announce the campaign was a great success! The goal for the campaign was to raise \$250,000 and we have exceeded that goal raising over \$285,000!

THANK YOU for your generosity as together we care for one of our greatest assets as a congregation, our church building. As a part of this campaign, we have completed and fully funded the following projects:

- A new electronic reader board sign on Red Oak Drive
- Updating and improving our HVAC including a new air conditioning unit for the office area and updated thermostat controls for the entire building
- Updating our fire and smoke detection systems throughout the building
- Filling cracks in our parking lot, sealing the parking lot and restriping the parking spaces
- Power washing and tuckpointing the brick exterior of the building as needed
- New phone system for the offices
- Updating every light in the building including new outside lights that shine on the building at night.
- A 10% benevolence given to organizations and projects outside our walls
- Added to the building reserve fund for future maintenance with any excess funds

What a reason to celebrate as God continues to bless us in our lives and use Abiding Savior and each one of us to bless the lives of others in God's name.

Stewardship Corner with Pastor Ryan Ways to Give to Abiding Savior

Now that we have completed the Abiding Here for 50 Years Capital Campaign, you might wonder what you can do with the money you were sharing with the campaign, or maybe at least part of those funds. There are several ways to make gifts to your congregation.

- 1. Cash or Check: You can make a cash or check gift in the offering plate at worship. This can be done in the offering envelopes provided or simply placed in the offering plate. If you would like credit on your statement for a cash gift, please be sure to use an envelope and provide us with your name. You can also mail your gifts to the church office or drop them off in person during the week.
- Electronic Giving: You can choose to make a gift from your checking account or on your credit card. Your gift can be set up to be given automatically monthly, weekly, or annually. You can also make a onetime electronic gift through our website or by using your phone and the QR code provided in the bulletin each week. (add QR code here)
- 3. Stocks, Bonds, IRAs or other Securities: The church receives several gifts of stocks, IRA's, and other securities throughout the year. This can be a great way to avoid paying taxes on the earnings from your investments while making a gift to Abiding Savior.
- 4. Required Minimum Distribution (RMD): If you are over 70 and a half years old, you can make a Qualified Charitable Donation (QCD) directly from you IRA as a non-taxable event. You avoid paying any taxes on the distribution and the distribution counts against your RMD
- 5. Estate Planning: It is simple and easy to include the Mission Endowment Fund of Abiding Savior in your will, trust, or other estate plans. These gifts will continue to fund the work of God done in and through our congregation for generations to come.

Tanzania Water Project Update and Tanzania Trip Planned for 2025

Abiding Savior has partnered with St. Paul Partners, the University of Minnesota, and the Village of Makungu, Tanzania, to design and build a freshwater distribution system to bring clean and safe drinking water to over 1,500 people in Makungu. So far, Abiding Savior has raised over \$18,000 for the project! The construction of the project is underway and should be completed soon.

We are planning a trip to visit the water project and our companion congregation, the Makungu Parish, in October of 2025. The trip will include travelling to Makungu for a weekend of worship and learning, a stay in the provincial capital of Iringa, and a safari in the Ruaha Game Park. Dietrich Bonhoeffer was a German Lutheran pastor and theologian who resisted Nazi tyranny during World War II. He was hanged in a Nazi prison camp for his actions and beliefs.

This four-session series will use videos by New York Times best-selling author Eric Metaxas to lead us into discussion and discovery. The series will explore the major themes of Dietrich Bonhoeffer's writing and speaking and how he not only helped transform an entire faith community in Germany during World War II, but how his beliefs continue to impact the Christian faith of people throughout the world today.


