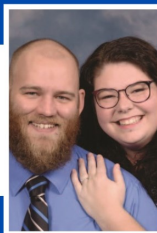

El Salvador Mission Trip Planned August 1-6, 2023

You are invited to participate in an intergenerational mission trip to El Salvador August 1-6, 2023. We have the opportunity to partner with Pilgrim Lutheran Church in Chicago and Pastor's Kristian and Anna-Kari Johnson, who have deep relationships and years of experience travelling to El Salvador. In El Salvador we will be the guests of the Lutheran Church of El Salvador and Pastors Matias and Martina Bonilla. The trip will be both participating in active ministry as well as learning about the culture and people of El Salvador. Some mission opportunities on this trip are to:

- *Share God's Love with Children*
- *Give Medical/Dental Care (nurses, doctors, and dentists/hygienists encouraged)*
- *Visit rural congregations serving resettled refugees*
- *Build homes and churches*
- *Help rural families without electricity get solar light*
- *Deliver medical supplies, computers, and donations*



The cost of the trip, before fundraising, is approximately \$1800 per person including airfare, accommodations, meals and transportation and we hope to that cost significantly through fundraising. The trip is led by Pastor Ryan Brodin of Abiding Savior Lutheran Church and Deacon Brad Mills of Cross of Glory and Atonement Lutheran Churches. **There will be an informational Meeting at Abiding Savior at 7:00 in the Coffee House following the 6:30 worship service on Wednesday, January 11**, with a non-refundable deposit of \$250 due by Wednesday, January 18. 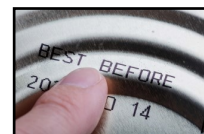
