Capital Campaign Updates

We are now entering the second year of our two-year *Abiding Here for 50 Years* Capital Campaign. So far we have raised over \$243,144 to make necessary improvements to our building. Thank you for your generosity!



Here are some updates on the Capital Campaign projects:

- New electronic reader board sign on Red Oak Drive: DONE. The new sign is up and working and looks amazing! This is the most visible of all of the projects in the capital campaign and gives our church an updated look while getting our information out to the community
- Updating our lights: DONE. Every light in the building has been updated
 with new LED bulbs including the outside lights that shine on the building at night. If you haven't driven by the church after dark, you should
 come check out these new accent lights around the outside of the Sanctuary.
- Filling cracks, sealing, and restriping the parking lot: DONE. The parking lot is one of our greatest and most expensive assets as a congregation. It is important that we be good stewards of this resource.
- Updated Fire Warning System: DONE. The City of Mounds View informed us that we needed to update our fire warning system in the building to communicate directly with the fire department if we have a fire emergency.
- Updates to our HVAC system. IN PROGRESS. We are updating all of our thermostats and entire HVAC system from 1973 technology to 2023 technology. This will help our HVAC system to run more efficiently. As a part of this project we also replaced the air conditioning unit to the office and Coffee House area that had not been working for over two years. This HVAC upgrade is the most expensive and least visible project in the capital campaign.
- Brick clean up and repair: SCHEDULED.
 This Fall the exterior of our building will be cleaned, the expansion joints replaced, and any repairs to broken bricks and mortar will be repaired.

Thank you again for your generosity as together we are good stewards of the church building God has entrusted to us.

Stewardship Corner

Where Are My Offering Envelopes?

That is a good question that we have been asking for the past seven months! Last winter our envelopes were shipped to the wrong location and never arrived at Abiding Savior. We expected the company to get us our envelopes, but it appears they are not able to do so. There will be no "official" offering envelopes for 2023.

That being said, you can still make your gifts to the congregation in several different ways:

- 1. We have printed temporary offering envelopes that are available at every worship service. You can place your offering in the envelope and write your name on the outside. NO ENVELOPE NUMBER IS NEEDED! With just your name we can be sure to track your giving appropriately for your annual statement.
- 2. We will have bundles of the temporary envelopes available that you can take home with you to mail in your offering or prepare your offering at home before coming to church.
- 3. Electronic giving is a great way to share! You can choose to make a gift from your checking account or on your credit card. Your gift can be set up to be given automatically monthly, weekly, or annually. You can also make a one time electronic gift through our website or by using your phone and the QR code provided.
- 4. The church receives several gifts of stocks, IRA's, and other securities throughout the year. This can be a great way to avoid paying taxes on the earnings from your investments while making a gift to Abiding Savior.

We are asking for small items that will pack easily into the personal baggage of the participants to be brought to El Salvador. Donations of cash are always the best donation. We will bring that money directly to El Salvador where it will be used where it is needed most. Please bring your donated items to the box located outside the Sanctuary in the Narthex.

Items they are seeking for donation are: toothbrushes and toothpaste, Tylenol, Ibuprofen, acetophenone, multi-vitamins, Band-aids, antibiotic ointment, thermometers, children's vitamins, pencils, scissors, calculators, pencil sharpeners, deflated soccer balls and pumps, hard candy, small toys, pens, other medical supplies, and cash donations.

Women's Bible Study When Bad Things Happen to Good People

Did you ever wonder why bad things happen to good people? It's a question most of us ask from time to time as we look around the world and see things that just don't seem fair. The women's Bible study group will be exploring this question in more depth this summer as we read and discuss the classic book by Rabbi Harold Kushner.

Rabbi Kushner's son, Aaron, was born with a debilitating illness that caused much suffering and resulted in Aaron's death at age 14. This personal experience of family suffering, combined with Rabbi Kushner's pastoral role in accompanying people in his congregation through many life challenges, prompted him to delve into the question of where God is at when bad things happen to good people. He looks to Old Testament scriptures, prayer, and his relationship with God to guide his consideration of this difficult life reality.

Abiding Savior secured a Thrivent Action Team grant for purchasing the books and a generous individual will be covering the rest. Any women in the congregation who would like to participate in this study are welcome. The Women's Bible Study group meets each week on Thursday mornings from 10:00 to about 11:30 in our church Coffee House, led by Pastor Marla. We'll be studying this book starting July 13 through the end of August. Copies of the book will be available for people to pick up prior to that in the church office. The chapters are short. It's an easy read. It helps to read it, but you can participate even if you don't read the book since the questions it addresses are common to all of us and our discussion will draw heavily on our own life experiences. We hope you'll join us!
