Getting to Know You!

There is a song that has been floating through my head from the musical. The King and I: "Getting to know you. getting to know all about you. Getting to like you, getting to hope you like me." It expresses very human feelings of hope and vulnerability at the start of a new relationship. Since I have recently begun serving as your new interim associate pastor, we are in the "getting to know you" phase. I'll share bit about myself and am eager to learn about you.



As a child I grew up in Wisconsin and was active in church and youth ministry. In 1989 Randy Amborn and I became engaged and chose for our church home, St. Stephen Lutheran Church in White Bear Lake. We were married there and our daughter, Marissa, was baptized and confirmed at St. Stephen. Throughout the years we have been active at St. Stephen many ways - with music, education, mission trips, church leadership and more.

As a teenager I felt a call to ministry, but it took a while to be able to fully respond to that call. For about 20 years I served as an instructor and administrator in higher education, teaching management and leadership in community and technical colleges. Eventually things came together for me to attend Luther Seminary in St. Paul and I was ordained in 2013.

I served as pastor at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Almelund, Minnesota, just north of the Twin Cities. As a pastor I love preaching and leading worship. One of the true privileges of being a pastor is getting to know the people of the congregation, walking with them in their faith and life journeys, being part of many of the tender and profound times of life. Mission work in Tanzania has also significantly shaped my life and ministry. In August of 2021 I retired from Immanuel to be able to care of our newborn grandson and my mother, who was having some medical challenges.

Now my mother is doing much better, and our grandson is attending a preschool program a couple of days a week, so we just have him with us one day a week. When the call came to serve as Abiding Savior's part-time interim associate pastor, it seemed that God had opened the way. The time was right, and it felt like a good fit all around. I'm very happy to be here.

As a person of faith, I believe that God is active in our lives and in the world and that if we genuinely seek to know God's will. God will reveal it to us and open the way for us to live into his plan. Prayer is an important part of my life of faith, coupled with Christian service to people near and far. I believe God's very nature is Love, and that when we live in love with God and one another we are serving as God's people in the world, doing the work God calls and equips us to do. What a joy it is to serve God and God's beloved children in the world!

That's a quick intro to me, I look forward to getting to know you. Visitation is a big part of my role here, so if you'd like a visit let me know. I'm eager to hear your story as we continue getting to know one another.

Making Gifts of Stocks, Bonds, Mutual Funds, Securities

Current tax laws can make it harder to see a tax advantage in your charitable giving. You can still see a tax advantage, even if you do not itemize your donations, by donating long-term appreciated securities, including stock, bonds, and mutual funds, directly to Abiding Savior. Compared with selling your appreciated securities and contributing the after-tax proceeds, you may be able to make a bigger impact by increasing your gift and your tax deduction.

Donating appreciated securities is simple and easy. When you donate stock, bonds or mutual funds to Abiding Savior, you'll generally take a tax deduction for the full fair market value. And because you are donating stock, bonds or mutual funds, your contribution and tax deduction may increase because you may not have to pay any capital gains tax on your appreciated securities.*

Donating your stocks, bonds, or mutual funds directly to Abiding Savior is a win-win situation. Instead of paying the IRS, that tax savings can be used to increase your donation toward the work of God done in and through our congregation. Contact your financial planner or accountant and ask them about the value of donating appreciated securities to Abiding Savior. Some creative givers even make two years of gifts to Abiding Savior with one sale of stock covering their pledge for the current year and the year to come.
