Special Congregational Meeting | May 5, 2024

Abiding Savior held a special congregational meeting on Sunday, May 5, to discuss the possibility of increasing the new Associate Pastor position from half-time to three-quarter-time. The St. Paul Area Synod has informed us that there is little to no interest from potential candidates for a half-time position, but the Synod believes there will be more interest in a three-quarter-time position. Also, the Church Council believes that increasing the Associate Pastor to three-quarter-time will not only attract a larger pool of candidates, but also help us better grow into the congregation our strategic plan envisions as we ensure the success and growth of our ministries both within and outside our church walls.

Therefore the following motion was unanimously passed at the meeting:

• To increase the 2024 budget by a total of up to \$8,333.33 (4 months) and the 2025 budget by a total of \$25,000.00 to allow for the possibility of calling a new Associate Pastor at ¾ time.
