Community Support Center



Tanzania Scholarships

Did you know that Abiding Savior currently supports/sponsors 11 students from the Makungu Parish in Tanzania by providing scholarships? The need for scholarships is so great because in



Tanzania there is no funding for children to continue their education past primary school when children are about 11 years old. In order to continue their education in secondary school (middle school/high school) they need to pay. The yearly cost for a child to attend secondary school is \$650 for tuition, room and board (as there are no second-

ary schools near the village). For most families in Makungu, \$650 is more income than a whole family would earn in an entire year. You can make a contribution to the Scholarship Fund at any time by putting "Tanzania" Scholarship" in the memo line. Once enough funds have been collected we can sponsor another student!
