Abiding Savior will still be our church home and we will continue to be part of the congregation. I will have to get used to the view from the back pews where Gary has sat all these years!

I can't begin to tell you how thankful I am for the honor and privilege of sharing life with you as a pastor at Abiding Savior. We have walked together through all that life brings: joys and sorrows, laughter and tears, and simply ordinary day to day life across all generations. Through sharing these experiences you have taught me what it means to live in faith and trust in God's steadfast love and grace giving us a future of hope.

After a period of several months off I may be open to a limited part-time pastoral care role at Abiding Savior. On Sunday, March 26th, I have been told there will be a gathering to celebrate my twenty-five plus years of service at Abiding Savior. I will be participating in Palm Sunday, Holy Week, and Easter services then close out my full-time responsibilities by the end of April. The Importance of Continued Generosity through Church Transitions



Abiding Savior has been blessed to have long tenures for their staff, especially their pastors. We are truly blessed to have this top notch Lutheran Choir performing in our Sanctuary.
