Lent, Holy Week and Easter Worship at Abiding Savior

What a joy it is to worship together! The music, the messages, the baptisms, the bread and wine, the prayers and the fellowship. The month of March is filled with opportunities for us to offer our praise, worship, and thanks to God. Abiding Savior is plan-



ning contemplative, meaningful and festive worship services as we journey together through Lent toward our Easter Celebration.

On Wednesday evenings, March 6, 13 and 20, at 4:00 and 6:30 we will continue our **Wednesday Lenten Worship** series. These half hour services are centered on the theme of "Dressed for Success: A Wardrobe of Faith" based on Colossians 3:12-17. We will explore being clothed in compassion, forgiveness, love, praise, and gratitude. We will also sing together the Holden Evening Prayer as our liturgy. And don't forget to come for soup supper served from 4:30 to 6:00.

On **Palm Sunday**, March 24, at 10:00, we will join in the celebration with a palm procession followed by a reading of the Passion of Christ from Luke acted out in vignettes of each event in the passion. This promises to be a moving experience of Jesus triumphant entry into Jerusalem and his last days.

During Holy Week we will have services at 4:00 and 6:30 on Maundy Thursday, March 28, and Good Friday, March 29. For Maundy Thursday we will receive Holy Communion and celebrate with those children receiving their First Communion. On Friday we will experience the last hours of Jesus life and remember the sacrifice he made for us on the cross.

Finally, on **Easter Sunday**, March 31, we will join in festive worship at 8:00 and 10:00 as together we celebrate the resurrection of our Lord and Savior! Christ is Risen! He is Risen Indeed!

Join us for these powerful and moving worship services during March.

Stewardship Corner

Jesus is After our Hearts, Not our Wallets!



We have heard it said that money is the root of all evil. Jesus often uses the wealthy as examples of greed, selfishness, and indifference. But Jesus never taught that it was a sin to be wealthy. In fact, Jesus befriended and even depended on people with wealth to fund his ministry and to participate in his building of the kingdom. It is not wealth that is the root of evil, it is actually the heart.

Jesus is after our hearts, not our wallets. Having wealth is not sinful, but what can be sinful is our relationship with that wealth and what we choose to do with that wealth. Do we trust wealth more than God? Do we make our decisions in life based on gaining more wealth or living lives worthy of being called disciples of Jesus? Do we cling to our wealth, unwilling to share with those who do not have enough?

Whether we want to admit it or not, we are wealthy when compared to most of the rest of the world. We have an abundance, more than enough. God does not find us sinful because we have an abundance. But what are we going to do with that abundance? Are we sharing freely and joyfully or are we holding back? Are we funding life changing ministries and community services? Do our hearts trust in God or in the security of our earthly possessions?

Jesus tells us, "Where you treasure is, there your heart will be also." If our hearts are set on wealth, then wealth is what we treasure above all else. If our hearts are set on God, then God is our treasure and we will use our abundance, our wealth, in service to God and neighbor.

With our hearts set on God, may we give joyfully and abundantly from the wealth God has entrusted to us!

Kris Linner, who wrote a book of stories from the perspective of biblical women that was such a hit for the Women's Bible Study, is writing some special stories for us as we explore the theme "Journeys of Faith." Stories are so powerful. As we hear these stories of God at work in and through women it will prompt us to think anew about how God is at work in our own lives.



We will have a comfortable mix of time in group sessions and free time to relax and explore. Some of the things you can do during free time include: hiking, canoeing, kayaking, games, puzzles, reading, walking a labyrinth, doing a service project for Days for Girls, sitting and looking out over the lake, relaxing by the fire, tennis, volleyball, journaling, napping, or whatever you want to do! All of this in the company of Christian friends. If you could use some time away, just for you, to nurture yourself in body and soul, join us!

The registration fee of \$250 includes room, meals, the retreat program, and equipment for all recreational activities. If you need scholarship help, just check with Pastor Marla. 
