We are excited to introduce Pastor K*, our recommended candidate for Associate Pastor. Pastor K is a recent graduate of Luther Seminary, and this would be her first call, as she is not yet ordained. She holds undergraduate degrees in History and Political Science from Luther College in Decorah, Iowa. Currently serving as a Director of Children, Youth, and Family Ministries at a suburban church in the Twin Cities area, Pastor K lives in Cottage Grove, MN.

Her passion for pastoral care, building relationships, and community connection shines through in all she does. While her primary background is in youth and family ministry, she also has a deep appreciation for senior ministry and visitation. Pastor K embraces traditional worship but is also open to exploring new styles and ideas. Her preaching style seeks to connect Scripture with everyday life—using personal stories, approachable language, and a love for the simplicity and meaning of worship.

The Call Committee found Pastor K to be engaging, authentic, deeply faithful, and a true fit for the heart and needs of our congregation. We are eager for you to get to know her and look forward to seeing you on May 4 at 11:15 AM for this important next step in our journey together.

Tanzania Trip Sign-Up Deadline May 14

We are planning a trip October 12-24, 2025, to visit the water project and our companion congregation, the Makungu Parish. The trip will include travelling to Makungu for a weekend of worship and learning, a stay in the provincial capital of Iringa, and a safari in the Ruaha Game Park. The cost of the trip will be approximately \$4,000 per person before fundraising. The deadline to sign up for the trip and make a \$500 deposit is Wednesday May 14.



Prayer shawls are a visible sign to the recipient that says "We are praying for you. You are cared for. We are thinking of you." They are a 'visible hug'! Abiding Savior's Prayer Shawl Ministry is a vibrant part of our outreach. Shawls have traditionally been knit or crocheted.

They are made with prayers, blessed at the altar, and distributed by our pastors, volunteer visitors and youwhen you know someone who will benefit from one. These shawls can be found in the prayer shawl cupboard in the library area. There are also note cards made by a member of our congregation to give with the shawls that give a little explanation about the ministry. The shawls and cards are here for anyone to give.

We are excited to announce a NEW aspect to this ministry! On Palm Sunday, as part of our intergenerational service event, several fleece prayer shawls and blankets were made. These were made BY our youth, FOR our youth. They are displayed on the ladder in the Narthex. Please feel free to take a shawl as needed for children and youth that you may know.



Abiding Savior Mission Endowment Fund 2025 Grant Recipients

In 2025, the Abiding Savior Mission Endowment Fund was able to fund grants totaling \$9,391. \$7,970 from the regular Endowment Fund, and \$1,421 from the Bonnie Kay Christiansen Fund to be used for education or children.
