With mixed emotions, I'm writing to let you know that my time as your ordained Deacon will be shortly drawing to a close. Please know that I had not been looking to leave Abiding Savior; I was approached by our nearby congregations, Cross of Glory and



Atonement, and was presented with an opportunity to help them out. As you may know, Cross of Glory and Atonement are a two-point parish that currently shares one pastor, and they were looking for additional ministerial assistance. This is a growth opportunity for me, as I will be transitioning away from a role as youth director and into a role as part-time associate minister. Through much discernment, I have felt called to take on this opportunity to further use and develop my gifts. Any hesitation I felt in making this decision was due to how much I love you all; in the past decade, you have not only supported my growth as a church leader, but you have literally watched and supported the growth of my family.

My wife, Karen, and our girls will be transitioning with me to the new churches. Karen will be stepping down from her role as council member. Karen wants you all to know that she has loved sharing her time with this community. We both feel honored and blessed for all the years together; you have all loved on our kids and have given them a safe, welcoming environment to grow knowing both our community and God.

I am grateful in knowing that I will remain nearby; our churches have historically been involved in partnership, and I look forward to that continuing. Most specifically, the El Salvador trip will be a partnership of Abiding Savior, Cross of Glory and Atonement with the partner church in Chicago, IL; please consider praying about this opportunity and joining us all.

Transitions are hard, even when good, but with them comes growth. I would like to leave you with the words from John where we get our name. My fervent hope is that this call for me and transition for me and my family will also bring new opportunities for you all.

John 15:1-12 - Jesus the True Vine: "I am the true vine, and my Father is the vinegrower. He removes every branch in me that bears no fruit.
