Growing Through Loss



All of our lives are touched by the experience of grief of some kind. We know the pain of loss, of sickness, of death, of separation, of changes in our lives. Grief is hard. We need to know we are not alone in grief.

Twin Cities Media Figure Pat Miles will Discuss her Book on End-of-Life Matters Before All is Said and Done

Local journalist Miles drew on personal experience and learnings after losing her spouse unexpectedly.

"The book underscores the importance of having critical discussions in advance of a loved one's dying and death. We're very pleased to offer these valuable insights to the White Bear Lake community," said Pastor Marla Amborn.

Following the talk there will be a reception with the author including refreshments.

Women's Bible Study News

The Women's Bible Study has been having lively and meaningful discussions sparked by reading "When Bad Things Happen to Good People." Fifty-one people have participated in person or online during this series. A big "Thank You" to Thrivent Financial for the Thrivent Action Team grant that covered a significant portion of the cost of these books, and to an anonymous doner who contributed so that the books could be free to participants!

During September, Pastor Marla will be away for a couple of weeks on vacation. During that time, we will have some travel discussions: Sept. 14 - Pastor Ryan with an El Salvador Trip Report & Sept. 21 - Pastor Lisa with a Norway Trip Report.

Starting in October we will focus on Women in the Gospels. Each week we'll read the scripture and hear the story of a woman in the Bible and discuss the questions raised by her situation. It will be a good time for people who haven't been part of the Women's Bible Study during the summer to join in Thursdays at 10am!

Living Prayer: Deepening our Communication with God

Lord, teach us to pray! Throughout the centuries, Christians have turned to God in prayer.
