Community Partners with Youth and Abiding Savior-15 Years Together

For the past fifteen years Abiding Savior has partnered with Community Partners with Youth (CPY) to serve at risk kids in our community. Every summer Abiding Savior has hosted the elementary program of CPY. Because of the generosity of Abiding Savior and others in our community, the summer program can be offered free of charge.

If not for CPY, these kids might not have a warm meal or a safe place to hang out for the summer. Through CPY the kids are able to take field trips together, do arts and crafts projects, and learn life skills like mela planning and cooking. Over the fifteen years of the program at Abiding Savior, easily over 1,000 kids have been served by CPY. That means tens of thousands of meals served out of our kitchen, hundreds of hours of playing games in the church yard, and so many lives that have been touched by CPY.

CPY is just one of many examples of how Abiding Savior is serving this community and beyond. Your generosity to Abiding Savior not only helps to support weekly worship, Bible Study, and pastoral care, but also outreach into the communi-

Growing Through Loss is a grief and loss support ministry jointly sponsored by the North Suburban Grief Support Coalition, of which 18 churches and organizations in our area are members. The coalition hosts two six-week series each year at various locations that address both the educational as well as support aspects of a variety of loss and grief issues.

The fall series will be held on Thursday evenings, September 5th through October 12th from 6:45 – 9:00 pm, at Nativity Lutheran Church, 3312 Silver Lake Road NE, St Anthony, MN 55418.

Each session offers an educational presentation by a professional from the community, followed by peer support groups facilitated by leaders who understand the grieving process.
