Ever wonder what a VBS volunteer does? Here are some great ways for you to get involved:

Activity Center Leader: Lead crafts, games or science activities as each group of children rotates through your activity center.

Activity Center Helper: Assist the leader of an activity center.

Group Leaders: We have 6 age-level groups. Group leaders are responsible for leading one group through the morning's activities and assisting as necessary. They are not responsible for leading activities.

Group Helpers: Assist with one of the age-level groups as they move from activity to activity throughout the morning.

Snack Team: Prepare, serve and clean up after the morning snack.

Sound Booth: Responsible for music, microphones and PowerPoint for the opening and closing gatherings each morning. If necessary, training will be provided given adequate lead-time.

Photographer(s): Observe and photograph activities from a variety of groups during the morning. If possible, prepare slide shows for use each morning, and for the Friday family closing, as well as the Sunday service the children present.

Roving Helper: Be available for assistance where it is needed each morning.

Prep-work: Prepare items for craft projects, etc.
