CONFIRMATION (B YEAR)

Begin by sharing your highs and lows from the past week.

Stewardship means a lot more than just giving money. It means sharing our time through volunteering our talents to God's service.

Take turns reading together about Spiritual Gifts from I Corinthians 12:4-21, 27-31

- 1. What is Paul (the author of Corinthians) trying to tell us in this passage about spiritual gifts?
- 2. Do we all have the same gifts? Why or why not?
- 3. Think about your body. Does each part have a specific function? Can the rest of the body work properly without each part? If one part is injured and hurts, does the whole body feel it?
- 4. How is the church like our body and each of us like individual parts of the body?
- 5. What would happen if we were all "a hand" or "an ear" in the body of Christ?
- 6. I Corinthians mentions healing and miracles and knowledge as gifts used within the church. Make a list of some of the gifts members of the church have today?
- 7. Take a moment and go around the group, naming a gift for each person as you see them. Remember, EVERYONE has been given a manifestation of the Spirit for the common good.
- 8. How can you use your gifts and talents to serve God?

Closing Prayer:

Join hands and have each person thank God for one of their talents.
