Discussion

- 1. Have you cared for a loved one as they approached death?
 - What did you pray for during that time?
 - What kinds of questions went through your mind?
- 2. What kind of relationship did Jesus have with Lazarus, Mary, and Martha?
- 3. Jesus intentionally delayed responding to Mary and Martha's request for him to come and heal their brother. Why did he delay?
 - When have you felt that God wasn't listening to you when you prayed?
 - How does this story speak to God's timing?
- 4. In this passage, Jesus wept over the death of his friend even though he knew he was going to raise him.
 - Why do you think Jesus wept?
 - What does it mean for us that Jesus wept?
 - How do tears bring people together around shared grief?
- 5. As you hear the story of Jesus raising Lazarus from the dead, does that comfort you?
 - Why or why not?
 - What questions does it raise for you?

- 6. Jesus told Mary he is the resurrection and the life. Do you think that is what she wanted to hear? Why or why not?
- 7. Have you ever attended a funeral or experienced a death of someone where there was no sense of eternal life?
 - How did that affect you?
 - What difference does the promise of resurrection make for us?
- 8. How do you think Lazarus experienced being raised from the dead?
- 9. What impact did the raising of Lazarus have on the people who witnessed it?
- 10. In our story, Martha spoke of the "tomb of turmoil" and the "tomb or doubt."
 - What tombs do we find ourselves in?
 - What binds us and keeps us there?
 - How do we get out?
- 11. How is God's power on display in this story?
 - What does that mean for us?
