  - What does this woman's example have to teach us about persistence in prayer?
- 6. Where does God meet us when we come to him with desperate situations?
- 7. The woman concluded that our struggles in life don't have the last word, but that God does. Has that been true for you?
  - Where have you experienced God's promises during times of trouble?

## Isaiah 43:1-3 & 5

But now thus says the Lord, he who created you, O Jacob, he who formed you, O Israel: Do not fear, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by name, you are mine. When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and through the rivers, they shall not overwhelm you; when you walk through fire you shall not be burned, and the flame shall not consume you. For I am the Lord your God, the Holy One of Israel, your Savior. I give Egypt as your ransom, Ethiopia and Seba in exchange for you. ...Do not fear, for I am with you
