Our God of Sharing (not our God of giving)

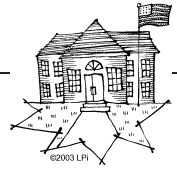

Community Partners with Youth (CPY) is the after-school and summer program that has strengthened this community by caring for our youth since 1997. It empowers at-risk youth through purposeful enrichment programs, quality mentorship, and life skills development. CPY is recognized for the high quality of its programming, and no one is turned away for financial reasons.

CPY has returned to Abiding Savior for an eighth summer! CPY grows in the summer, when school is not in session. They operate both an elementary program at Abiding Savior and a middle school program at Christ the King Lutheran Church in New Brighton.

CPY is led by two full-time employees, executive director Mary Stewart and program director Kao Yang. It is a non-profit organization funded through its community partners: the faith community, City of New Brighton, Mounds View Public Schools, foundation and government grants, civic organizations, business partners, and faithful individual supporters. Currently, the Board of Directors includes Maxine Smedshammer from Abiding Savior as a local resident.

CPY's Mission:

To provide a safe, nurturing environment where youth can strengthen their personalities and develop educational and social skills.

CPY's ultimate goal is to model and teach youth how to care for one another and themselves with respect, dignity and integrity.
